Health21 Online Nationwide Lecture Series

In concert with the forums, Health21 will begin a series of online nationwide lectures to facilitate education and outreach of forum and other timely topics. Each series will include 10 or more expert, online lectures. And each lecture will accommodate 50 people to allow an opportunity to ask questions and participate in conversation with the experts leading the engagement. These will be provided to target market segments like professional associations and institutions of higher learning throughout the United States and abroad. Of particular importance is the need to promote this opportunity to students, faculty and staff at community colleges, particularly those in resource poor settings that may not otherwise have an opportunity to interact with such experts or to participate in such dialogue. International outreach is also planned to professional organizations in resource poor nations to promote equal opportunity, increased collaboration and relationship building, and interoperability. As such, the series will seek to maximize diversity for purposes of supporting interdisciplinary, innovative environments.

Each lecture in a topical series will last 50-60 minutes with time allotted for questions or interactive dialogue, thus bringing the time commitment for lecturer and participant to approximately 90 minutes. The lecture series will build off speaker presentations at forums while including additional or new speakers and topics. This is an excellent opportunity for academicians, private industry and federal health to promote their work and expertise to universities, students and markets while building relationships and creating collaboration opportunities. Biographical information on each speaker and additional pertinent information will be provided prior to the beginning of each series and/or lecture.

Furthermore, participation in an online lecture series can provide a valuable opportunity toward fulfilling CEUs.

Additional series are only limited by available, quality, expert lecturers on topics that promote a new vision of wellness and health care for the betterment of all. Ultimately, the goal is to increase exposure of innovative processes and expertise that promotes interoperability and free exchange of ideas within cutting edge practices that build long-standing relationships within a collaborative network. Several post-secondary schools have already expressed interest in providing these series as course curriculum to their students – undergraduate, graduate and professional level.
